MEMBER'S DETAILS FORM

Membership:

All current members of the University and all alumni / alumnae, staff and former staff of the University with a connection to Gloucestershire are automatically entitled to be members of the Society. Associate Membership is open to 'spouses' of Members who, having once become an Associate Member, may always remain one.

Provided that a Member accepts information from the Society by email, communicates with the Society by email and makes payment for events by BACS, there is no annual Membership Subscription. For those Members wishing to use the post or pay by non-electronic means, the annual Membership Subscription is £10. The membership year is the calendar year.

Data Protection:

Your personal details as provided will be added to the Society's database for use in communicating with you appropriately. Your data will be stored on password protected computers and backed up on data servers which may not be located in the UK. The data is made available to the current committee members and sometimes the names of those attending a function will be made available to other attendees (e.g. the annual dinner). No data is released to any third party except to check eligibility for membership with Colleges and/or CUDAR (Cambridge University Development and Alumni Relations).

Provided that consent has been given, the Secretary and the Membership Secretary are willing to forward emails to other members to whom your email address will be disclosed as part of the forwarding. The other member will need to reply direct to you for you to obtain their email address or any of their other details.
